

## Virtual Foster Program Tip Sheet – Outings

The PHS Virtual Foster Program allows you to take your Virtual Foster Dog on a field trip! Follow these steps to ensure that your outing is safe and fun for everyone involved.

- 1. Check out with the front desk to let them know that your pet is leaving the building. A staff member will record your pet's name, your contact information for the day, where you are going, and when you are expected to return.
- 2. Be sure a staff member verifies that your pet's collar and harness are properly fitted. Don't forget the "adopt me" bandanna!
- 3. Secure the pet in your vehicle using a crate, dog seatbelt, or the help of another person who is at least 16 years old. We can't say how our pups will behave in the car, and a loose critter is a moving vehicle is dangerous!
- 4. Head to your favorite pet-friendly park, trail, restaurant, or brewery and enjoy it with your Virtual Foster Pet.
- 5. Check back in with the front desk when you return. All field trip pups must be back to PHS by 4 pm daily (3 pm on Sundays).

## For safety reasons:

- Do not allow anyone except yourself to hold the Virtual Foster Pet's leash.
- Do not visit dog parks or other areas where dogs may be off leash.
- Do not allow your Virtual Foster Pet to interact with other animals when off-site. This includes your personal pets!
- In the event of an emergency, call PHS at 757-397-6004. Only a PHS staff member may authorize veterinary care for a PHS pet.
