

# LOW-COST VET CARE



Just like us, pets need regular medical care. This document is broken into five categories.

1. **Spay/Neuter Clinics** offer sterilization services for pets but may not offer other care.
2. **Vaccine Clinics** provide inexpensive vaccinations but may not offer appointments or other care. Expect long wait times.
3. **Full Service Clinics** offer illness and injury treatment.
4. **Hospice** offers end of life care and euthanasia.
5. **Emergency Medical Assistance** covers nonprofits that provide financial help to those with immediate, urgent need.

Note: there are no low-cost emergency clinics in Hampton Roads. Due to the demand for low-cost care, wait times for return phone calls and appointments will be longer than those for traditional veterinary clinics.
